DamShel Audition Policy

As DamShel produces new Australian plays, there is no formula for the timeframe within which casting for a particular show may be carried out as new scripts shift and change in the development process. We encourage anyone who is interested to audition and we welcome new faces and fresh talent to our productions. Except as specifically required by the script for certain roles, DamShel policy is to cast regardless of colour, race or disability.

1. Director's Discretion

The casting of each show is an on-going process. From the time a show is in development, DamShel Productions is working with the director of the show to cast the best people for the roles. Some casting is done immediately from actors whose work is already known to the company and to the director; the remaining roles are cast from Show Specific Auditions.

2. The Audition

You will be provided with a monologue and an excerpt from the play to perform at the audition with another actor. It is expected that you will know these parts and be able to perform them off-script at the audition. Failure to learn lines, or perform to an acceptable level, to be determined solely by the casting director, may result in your Audition being terminated early and non-consideration for a role.

3. Call Backs

Callbacks will be held if necessary. Not being called back does not mean that auditionees are not cast in the show. Likewise, being called back does not mean they will be cast.

4. Arrival

You must arrive for your Audition fifteen (15) minutes prior to the Audition time provided to you.

5. Inability to Attend

If you become aware of circumstances that make you unable to attend your scheduled audition time please contact DamShel using the details provided on your audition notice.

All auditions will be filmed for reference throughout the audition and casting process.

Please note that by auditioning, you are obligating yourself to a considerable rehearsal and performance process. Please be certain that you are willing and able to make this commitment.
